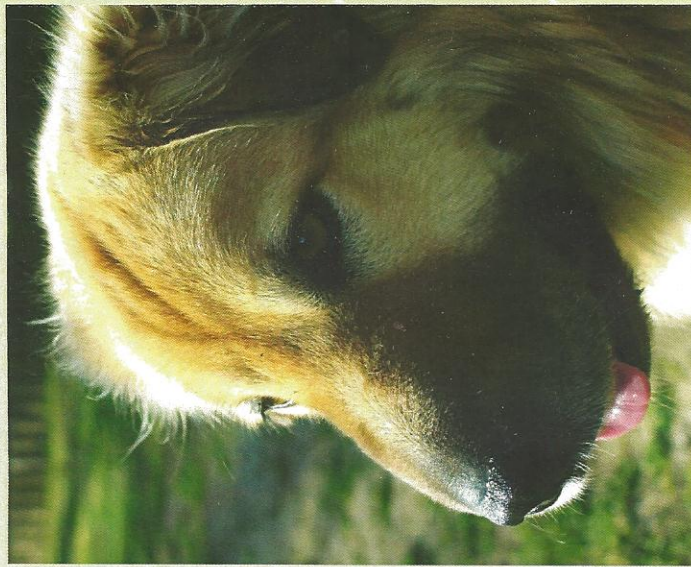

Dr. Wedemeyer graduated from Cambridge University in England in 2004, with degrees in veterinary medicine and pharmacology. After seeing how animals often still suffered symptoms despite conventional treatment, she became interested in acupuncture and became certified by the International Veterinary Acupuncture Society in 2005. She continued her study of Chinese medicine by gaining certification in Chinese herbal medicine, *Tui-na* (a form of medical massage) and food therapy.

In 2010, Dr. Wedemeyer joined the faculty of the Chi Institute of Chinese Medicine in Florida, the premier training institute for vets interested in Chinese medicine. She now teaches both acupuncture and herbal medicine at Chi. Dr. Wedemeyer is also an established author and editor for Chinese veterinary medicine, with two Chinese medical textbooks she has worked on due to be published this year. She is an editor for the American Journal of Traditional Chinese Medicine, which promotes research and development in Chinese veterinary medicine, to help veterinarians continue to supplement their education and develop best practices.
